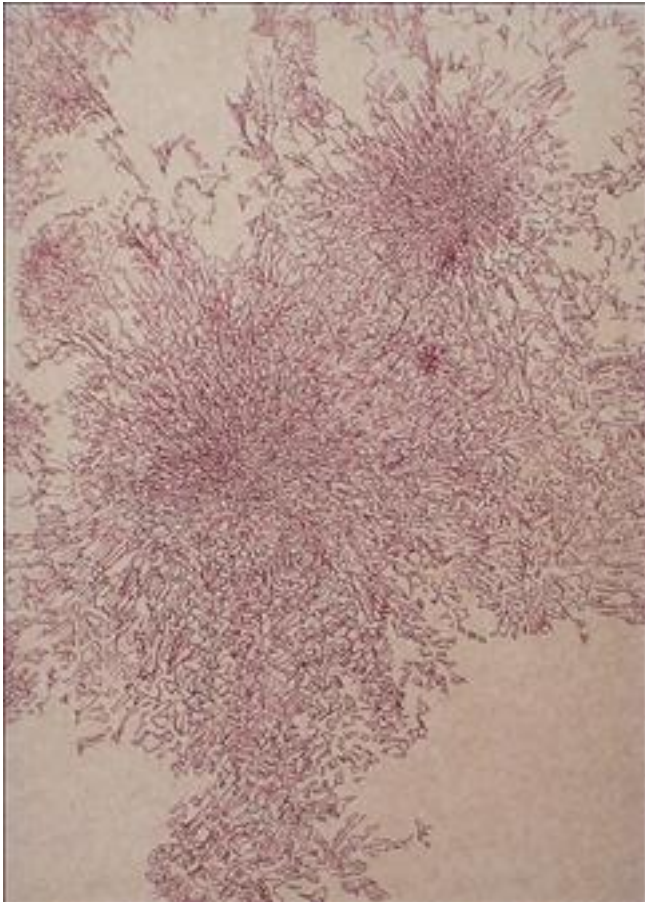


Sachie Koyama Displays Atmospheres of Inspiration in the Matrix of the Mind at Agora Gallery

Chelsea's Agora Gallery will feature Japanese artist, Sachie Koyama, in The Matrix of the Mind. The exhibition is scheduled to run from February 26, 2010 through March 19, 2010 (opening reception: Thursday, March 04, 2010).

Sachie Koyama's exquisite drawings and paintings display a lightness and sensitivity that truly mark her works as outstanding. With no theoretical basis from which to start, she draws inspiration intuitively from nature in its most elemental forms - wind, air, water. Her interest in the fundamentals is also displayed in her works based on seeds, in which linear abstraction draws one into a plane of intricate maze-worlds. Koyama employs delicate strokes to layer up her works, creating soft, highly textured, two-dimensional compositions. Her aim is to create atmospheric works, and she achieves this through a subtle balance of shape and color. Many different media are employed to this end, including oils, watercolors, pastels and acrylics to name but a few. Koyama attributes the combination of subtle markings and a sensitivity to nature and the changing of the elements to her close connection to traditional Japanese culture.

Sachie Koyama currently lives and works in Japan.
