This seminar will introduce breaking down task sequences (e.g., daily living skills, chores, leisure skills, morning/night routines, full day schedules) into component parts to establish skills and increase independence using chaining methods across the life span for individuals with autism spectrum and related disabilities. Prompting and prompt fading will be reviewed and an interactive exercise will be included.
