Although, the couple (Danielle King and Marc Daratt) seem oddly matched, an unexpected disaster brings them closer together to make their date unforgettable. The film also stars Mary Robinson, Wesley Blake, Laura Evans and Everette Henderson.

Estrada was also a part of the PrimaDonna production of the film “Crush” in July.
