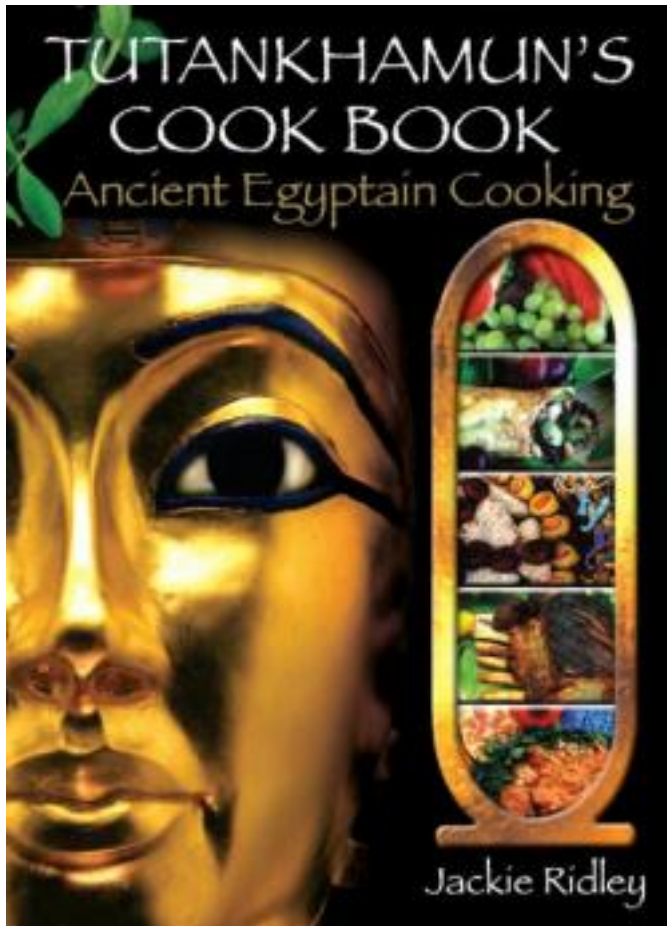


## "Tutankhamun's Cook Book" - A Study on Ancient Egyptian Recipes
