Riley County, KS – January 15, 2008 - Simplifile announced today that they will begin electronically recording (eRecording) land record documents such as deeds, mortgages, and reconveyances submitted by title companies, abstractors, banks, and attorneys, in the Riley County Register of Deed's Office.

To introduce the public to eRecording, Riley County is hosting an eRecording kick-off meeting from 1:30 pm until 3:30 pm, Thursday, January 24, 2008 in the Riley County Office Building (located at 110 Courthouse Plaza, 2nd Floor Conference Room), in Manhattan Kansas. Simplifile representatives will be in attendance to demonstrate the system and to conduct a question and answer session.

eRecording is the process of submitting, receiving, and processing, via a secure Internet site, documents for recording that have traditionally been delivered to the county for recording by runner, express mail, or courier service. eRecording offers customers the ability to simplify and accelerate all aspects of the recording process, dramatically shortening the Gap and improving auditability.
