"Don't be afraid of.. Joomla!" is the title of a new downloadable ebook about the free popular web content management system Joomla (formerly Mambo). There is a vast amount of modules and add-ons for Joomla, but hardly any documentation for beginners on how to set up a website from nil with the new 1.5 version.

This pdf tutorial by Timothy Walters explains on 230 pages with over 170 (!) screenshots step-by-step in 20 chapters issues like how to install Joomla, change templates, create sections and categories, add articles, banners and user login by using a popular news release website as an example.
