The PCI-Express x16 slot accepts modern dual-slot graphics cards while a heatpipe cooling system and linear controlled fans cool the components. The additional OASIS passive cooling element effectively reduces the temperature of the chipset and ensures the stable operation of the Mini-PC - even under heavy load.
