Algonquin Lakeside Inn's Loon Photography Tour operates through the spring, summer and fall and changes with the seasons. Depending on the time of year, tour participants can observe these magnificent birds nesting, with chicks, or in the fall preparing for their flight south. Spring in Algonquin Park can be one of the best seasons for wildlife viewing as animals are out and about searching for food, after ending their winter hibernation. When the weather gets too hot in the summer, some of the animals move further into the forest and are not quite as easy to spot. May and June are the big months for moose watching in Algonquin Park. In May, Algonquin Lakeside Inn is offering a Spring Moose Photography Packages on land and, in June and early July, Cows & Calves Moose Photography Packages by boat are available. Moose rutting season is in October and a Bull Moose in Rut Package is available. This exciting full day photography package takes place on both land and water and is certain to be memorable.
